APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 272,273,414 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act,2016.

Petitioner is driver of the three wheeler from which more than 100 liters of Nepali liquor was recovered. Petitioner has stated on oath that he has got no criminal antecedent.

Considering the nature of allegation and quantum of punishment prescribed for the alleged offence, in my view, the petitioner should be released on bail **only after framing of the charges** on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the



satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Basopatti Police Station Case No.309 of 2019(G.R.No.2307 of 2019), subject to the condition that both bailors shall be resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below as well as petitioner shall not leave the country without permission of the Court and further the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
