The petitioner prays for release of the vehicle namely Morotcycle bearing registration no. BR-33AE-3629 seized in connection with Mansurchak P.S. Case No. 74 of 2019 for the offences punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar



Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner invites our attention to the order dated 9th January, 2020 passed in CWJC No. No.20598 of 2019 titled as Md. Shaukat Ali Vs. The State of Bihar & Ors. and prays for disposal in terms thereof.

As such, as prayed for, on mutually agreed terms, we dispose of the present petition in terms of the order dated 9th January, 2020 passed in CWJC No. No.20598 of 2019 titled as Md. Shaukat Ali Vs. The State of Bihar & Ors. making the terms contained therein, applicable mutatis mutandis, insofar as applicable, also to the instant petition. The terms of the said order shall be deemed to have been incorporated and read as a part and parcel of the present order.
