2 19-02-2020 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

Petitioners seeks bail in connection with Balthar P.S. Case No.78 of 2019 registered for the offence punishable under sections 20,22,23,25 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submit that earlier prayer of the petitioner was rejected by this Court vide order dated 21.11.2019 in Cr. Misc. No.73555 of 2019 with observation that petitioner may renew his prayer for bail after framing of charge. Further submits that charges have already



been framed and petitioners are in custody since 21.08.2019.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sessions Judge, West Champaran at Bettiah in connection with Balthar P.S. Case No.78 of 2019.
