ORAL ORDER

2 21-01-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the respondents.

Petitioner has prayed for the following relief:

“(a) To remove encroachment on Nala so that drainage should be free from any obstacle.

(b) To direct to the authorities concerned to complete Ganga drainage work as most of the work has been left half way which is causing difficulties to the people specially of, Kadam



Kuan, Rajendra Nagar, Patliputra Colony and other localities residents.

(c) To give direction to the Government to take immediate steps and to hold enquiry as why the pumping stations are not functional.

(d) To direct to declare the fund received for maintenance of pumps and Nalas for last ten years.”

After the matter was heard for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner shall be content if a direction is issued to the concerned respondents to consider and decide the representation, which the petitioner shall be making afresh within a period of four weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the State states that upon receipt of such request, if any, the same shall be dealt with in accordance with law, expeditiously and positively within a period of three months from the date of receipt thereof.

Equally, liberty is reserved to the petitioner to take recourse to such alternative remedies as are otherwise available in accordance with law.

We are hopeful that as and when petitioner takes recourse to such remedies, as are otherwise available in law,



before the appropriate forum, the same shall be dealt with, in
accordance with law and with reasonable dispatch.

The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
