learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are in custody in connection with
Gaya RPF Case No. 26 of 2019 for the offenses under Section
3 of the R.P. (U.P.) Act.

In the instant case on secret information 49 Computer
Monitors were recovered which is said to be the railway
property.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioners have no criminal antecedent. The petitioners are in
custody since 26.10.2019. Nothing was recovered from the
conscious possession of the petitioners.



Considering the fact that nothing was recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners and the petitioners have no criminal antecedent, let the petitioners, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 50,000/-(Fifty Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Railway Gaya in connection with Gaya RPF Case No. 26 of 2019.
