ORAL ORDER

2 25-02-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned A.P.P for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in **Kudra P.S.**
Case No. 319 of 2019, registered for the offence punishable
under Sections 147, 149, 341, 323, 325, 307, 353, 332, 333, 504
and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

The informant (police official) alleged that he got
information about altercation between two groups and when the
police reached there, the members of both the groups started
pelting stones on the police party, as a result of which some of
the police personnel became injured.

It is submitted that petitioner has falsely been
implicated in this case merely on suspicion. FIR is against 35
named including this petitioner and 100-150 unknown.



Petitioner is one of the members of mob. Moreover, similarly situated co-accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail by a coordinate Bench of this court vide order dated 20.12.2019 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 84857 of 2019. Petitioner has got clean antecedent.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the petitioner above-named in the event of his arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned **Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate VI, Kaimur at Bhabua** in connection with **Kudra P.S. Case No. 319 of 2019**, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure with further conditions:-

(i) The petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the court and shall remain physically present as directed by the Court and in the event of failure on two consecutive dates without sufficient reasons, his bail bond shall be liable to be cancelled by the court below.



(ii) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
