2 23-01-2020 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Parasi P.S.Case No.66 of 2019 read with Excise Case No.1283 of 2019 , registered for offences punishable under Sections 30(A)(D) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, of the Indian Penal Code.

Police on information of manufacturing of liquor raided the place of the occurrence and the petitioner succeeded in fleeing away. There was recovery of liquor and another articles.



Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioners is that the allegation is vague and no source of identification is mentioned and they are having no criminal antecedent.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned ADJ-II, Jehanabad in connection with Parasi P.S.Case No.66 of 2019 (Excise Csaе No.1283 of 2019), subject to conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

With the above direction, this application is allowed.
