Learned advocate for the State produces the case diary and draws the attention of this Court to the injury report.

We have perused the case diary as also the injury report which reflects that the injured sustained serious injuries which are grievous in nature.

Having considered the same, we are not inclined to extend the relief for anticipatory bail to the present petitioners. As such, the

prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is rejected.
