The petitioner undertakes to affirm and appropriately stamp the petition as per the Rules within 48 hours of resumption of normal functioning of the Court. The petition is taken up through video conference on the basis of such undertaking.

The petitioner claims to be in custody for more than 75 days and says that the principal accused has been granted bail.

The incident is of December, 2018 and the petitioner is alleged to have inflicted gun-shot injuries on the survivor.

The State says that the petitioner was absconding and was arrested only earlier this year.

Considering the fact that the bullets were fired and the petitioner absconded for more than a year, the prayer for bail is rejected at this stage.

are disposed of.
