subject e-tender process, I am of the view that no legal right
of the petitioner stands violated through the impugned e-
tender process. Therefore, I am not minded to interfere in
the e-tender process at the behest of the petitioner.

W.P.A. 6491 of 2020 is disposed of without any order as to costs.
