Petitioners undertake to affirm and stamp the petition/application as per Rules within a month of resumption of normal functioning of the Court. Subject to such undertaking, the application is taken up for hearing through video conference.

Accordingly, the application, being CRAN 1 of 2020 (Old No. CRAN 4573 of 2020), is disposed of.

Having considered the materials on record disclosing prima facie involvement of the petitioners in torturing the victim/house wife who suffered unnatural death within 2 ½ years of marriage, we are of the opinion that in view of the

gravity of the offence, we are not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is rejected.
