In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with Berhampore Women P.S. Case No.99 of 2020 dated 21.07.2020 under Sections 498A/307/354/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner undertakes to affirm and stamp the petition/application as per Rules within one month of resumption of normal functioning of the Court. Subject to such undertaking, the application is taken up for hearing through video conference.

Having considered the materials on record and bearing in mind the nature of allegations in the light of the submission that the incident occurred 9 years after matter and as the allegation of physical assault is not supported by medical papers, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner namely, Nabijul Sk @ Nobijul Sk be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the

petitioner shall meet the investigating officer once in a week until further orders.

Accordingly, application for anticipatory bail being CRM 6283 of 2020 is disposed of.

The application being CRAN 1 of 2020 (Old CRM 4803 of 2020) is disposed of.

The parties shall act in terms of the copy of the order downloaded from the official website of this court.
