In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with Mahestala P.S. Case No.161 of 2020 dated 08.04.2020 under sections 447/448/186/332/353/506/427/24 of the Indian Penal Code read with section 51 D.M. Act.

Petitioners undertake to affirm and stamp the petition/application as per Rules within one month of resumption of normal functioning of the Court. Subject to such undertaking, the application is taken up for hearing through video conference.

Having considered the materials on record and bearing in mind the general and omnibus nature of allegations and as no injury report is produced with regard to assault on the public servant, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners namely, (1) Sukumar Sardar, (2) Ramesh Naskar, (3) Rakesh Naskar and (4) Surya Mondal be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 on further condition that the

petitioners shall meet the investigating officer once in a week until further orders.

Accordingly, application for anticipatory bail being CRM 6292 of 2020 is disposed of.

The application being CRAN 1 of 2020 (Old CRM 4811 of 2020) is disposed of.

The parties shall act in terms of the copy of the order downloaded from the official website of this court.
