The advocate-on-record for the petitioner undertakes to affirm and properly stamp the petition as per the rules within a month of resumption of normal functioning of the court. The petition is taken up through video-conference on the basis of such undertaking. CRAN No.1 of 2020 is disposed of.

It was brought to our notice at the instance of the learned advocate for the State on September 9, 2020 that on a previous occasion, this petitioner's prayer for anticipatory bail was rejected on November 25, 2019 by this court. However, on the prayer of the learned advocate appearing for the petitioner to ascertain the correctness of the submission made on behalf of the State, it was adjourned until September 14, 2020.
