Petitioners undertake to affirm and stamp the petition/application as per Rules within a month of resumption of normal functioning of the court. Subject to such undertaking, the application is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Accordingly, the application being 1 of 2020 is disposed of.

Having considered materials on record disclosing prima facie involvement of the petitioners i.e. parents in law of the victim housewife in subjecting her to torture resulting in her unnatural death within six months of marriage, we are of the opinion that in view of the gravity of the offence this is not a fit case to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail is rejected.
