The petitioner undertakes to affirm and stamp the petition as per the Rules within a month of resumption of normal functioning of the court. The petition is taken up through video conference on the basis of such undertaking.

The application being IA No. CRAN/1/2020 is disposed of.

Having considered the materials on record and bearing in mind the extent of complicity of the petitioner in the alleged crime and as co-accused persons, who were present at the spot alongwith the principal accused, has been enlarged on bail, we are inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly we direct that the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned ACJM, Barrackpore, North 24 Parganas

subject to condition that the petitioners shall appear before the trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate the witnesses and/or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event the petitioners fail to appear before the trial court without justifiable cause, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel his bail in accordance with law without further reference to this Court.

The application for bail is, accordingly, allowed.

CRM 7181 of 2020 is disposed of.
