Petitioner claims that the petitioner was not awarded marks for M-Phil degree and other publications which the petitioner is entitled in the selection process for filling up of the post of Assistant Professor of Library Science.

West Bengal College Service Commission is represented by Mr. Pulak Ranjan Mondal.

In the facts of the present case, since there is a claim that the petitioner is entitled to marks for a degree obtained and publications made it would be appropriate to request the Secretary of the West Bengal College Service Commission to consider the writ petition of the petitioner as a representation and to pass a reasoned order thereon. The Secretary, West

Bengal School Service Commission will give a reasonable opportunity of hearing to the petitioner. He is at liberty to hear such other parties and consult such documents that he deems appropriate. He will pass a reasoned order which he will communicate to the petitioner forthwith thereafter. It is expected that, the entire exercise is completed within a period of four weeks from the date of communication of this order.
