In the event, respondent no.2 is of the view that, the petitioner is entitled to pensionary benefits, he will take appropriate measures with regard thereto. In the event, the respondent no.2 is of the view that, the petitioner is not entitled to any pensionary benefits, he will communicate his reasoned order to the petitioner forthwith thereafter.

It is expected that, the entire exercise is completed by the respondent no.2 within a period of six weeks from the date of communication of this order.
