Having considered the materials on record and bearing in mind the nature of allegations in the light of the submission that there is inordinate delay in lodging FIR, we are of the opinion that custodial interrogation of the accused/petitioners is not necessary in the facts of the present case and they may be granted anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the accused/petitioners, namely ***(1) Iyaut Khan @ Yaut Khan & (2) Isha Khan***, be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
