In re: An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 in connection with Gazole Police Station Case No. 234 of 2020 dated 07.06.2020 under Sections 376/506 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner undertakes to appropriately stamp the petition as per the Rules within one month of resumption of normal functioning of the court. The petition is taken up through video conference on the basis of such undertaking.

Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the present case is nothing but a counterblast since there is a land dispute between the parties.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail and produces the case diary.

After perusing the case diary and medical

report, in our considered view the petitioner should be granted anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, we allow the prayer for anticipatory bail.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties of like amount, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer of the case.

The aforesaid order shall be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

The application for anticipatory bail being C.R.M. 8296 of 2020 is disposed of.
