**C.R.M. 8368 of 2020

Having considered the materials on record and bearing in mind the facts and circumstances of the case in the light of the submission that there was a domestic quarrel between the parties, we are of the opinion though custodial interrogation of the petitioner may not be necessary, movement of the petitioner requires to be restricted in order to instil confidence in the mind of the de facto complainant.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner shall not enter while on bail the jurisdiction of Narkeldanga P.S except for investigation and/or attending the court proceeding until further orders and he shall provide the addresses where he shall reside while on bail to the Investigating Officer as well as to the court below and on

further condition that petitioner shall report to the Officer-in-Charge of the concerned P.S within whose jurisdiction he shall reside while on bail once a week until further orders.

The application being CRM 8368 of 2020 is disposed of.
