In Re: An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with Raghunathganj P.S. Case No. 497 of 2020 dated 08.10.2020 under Sections 448/323/325/326/427/379/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation of physical assault may be assessed in the light of the submission that there was a free fight over construction in the locality. Injuries also do not appear to be grievous. Accordingly, we are inclined in granting anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
