In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with Hogalberia P.S. Case No.124 of 2020 dated 05.09.2020 under sections 498A/325/307/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Having considered the materials on record prima facie disclosing involvement of the petitioner no. 1 in assaulting the victim housewife which is supported by medical evidence, we are not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner no. 1.

Keeping in mind the extent of complicity of the petitioner nos. 2 and 3 in the alleged crime, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to them.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner nos. 2 and 3 shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, partly allowed.
