Having considered the materials on record and bearing in mind the general and omnibus nature of allegations and in view of the fact that the petitioner did not play a primary role in the alleged assault, we are of the opinion that custodial interrogation of the accused/petitioner is not necessary and he may be granted anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the accused/petitioner, namely ***Mithun Mondal***, be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
