It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that there was a love affair between the parties and the marriage was not accepted by the parents of the victim. She committed suicide at her parental home.

Learned layer for the state opposes the payer for anticipatory bail.

Having considered the materials on record and bearing in mind the nature of allegations in the light of the aforesaid submissions made on behalf of the petitioner, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

The application being CRM 9229 of 2020 is disposed of.
