In Re: - An application for bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Sonarpur** P.S. Case No. **571/17** dated **02.04.2017** under Sections **395/396/397** of the Indian Penal Code and Sections **25/27/35** of the Arms Act and Section **14** of the Foreigners Act and Sections **3/4** of the Explosives Act and charge-sheet submitted against the petitioner under Sections **395/396/397/212/412/120B** of the Indian Penal Code and Section **14C** of the Foreigners Act.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner stands on the same footing with the co-accused persons who has been enlarged on bail.

Learned lawyer for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

Having considered the materials on record and bearing in mind the facts and circumstances of the case and on principle of parity, we are inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Let the petitioner be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Baruipur, South 24-Parganas, subject to the condition that during bail the petitioner shall appear before the learned trial court regularly till disposal of the trial and the petitioner shall not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event the petitioner fails to comply with the conditions as enshrined hereinbefore, it is open to the trial court to cancel the bail without any further reference to this Court.

The application for bail is, thus, disposed of.
