Having considered the materials on record and bearing in mind the general and omnibus nature of allegations, we are of the opinion custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not necessary and they may be granted anticipatory bail.

In the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
