Having considered the materials on record disclosing prima facie involvement of the petitioners i.e. mother-in-law and sister-in-law respectively in torturing the victim-housewife who suffered unnatural death within five years of marriage by consuming poison, we are of the opinion that in view of the gravity of the offence this is not a fit case to grant anticipatory bail to them.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners stands rejected.
