In Re: - An application for bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Habra** P.S. Case No.**420 of 2020** dated **05.09.2020** under Sections **341/325/363/365/376/506** of the Indian Penal Code and Section **6** of the POCSO Act and Section **3** of the Prohibition of Child Marriage Act.

Having considered the materials on record and bearing in mind the nature of allegations in the light of the submission that there was a love affair between the parties and in view of the period of detention already suffered by the petitioner i.e. about 90 days and as the investigation is complete, we are inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Let the petitioner be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Learned Judge, Special Court under POCSO Act, Barasat, North 24-Parganas subject to the condition that during bail the petitioner shall appear before the learned trial court regularly till disposal of the trial and the petitioner shall not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event the petitioner fails to comply with the conditions as enshrined hereinbefore, it is open to the trial court to cancel the bail without any further reference to this Court.

The application for bail is, thus, allowed.
