

C.R.M. 9817 of 2020

In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with Contai P.S. Case No. 119 of 2020 dated 19.03.2020 under sections 498A/306 of the Indian Penal Code and section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

And

In the matter of: Sk. Ainuddin & Ors.

Allegations are general and omnibus in nature. Incident occurred 15 years after marriage. Victim did not leave behind any suicide note implicating the petitioners.

Under such circumstances, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
