

C.R.M. 9925 of 2020

In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with Balurghat P.S. Case No.211 of 2020 dated 25.06.2020 under sections 21(c)/22(c)/27A/27B/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act.

No narcotic substance was recovered from the petitioner. Complicity of the petition has transpired from the statement of co-accused before police officer which is inadmissible in evidence.

In view of the aforesaid factual matrix petitioner has been able to rebut the statutory restrictions under section 37 of the NDPS Act. Accordingly, he may be granted anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
