In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with Panchla P.S. Case No.208 of 2020 dated 07.09.2020 under sections 363/365/34/376(iii) of the Indian Penal Code and sections 4/6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act.

Having considered the materials on record and bearing in mind the nature of allegations in the light of the submission that there was love affair between the parties and as the statement of the victim is exonerative in nature, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
