**CRM 9990 of 2020

In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Chakdah** P.S. Case No.**343 of 2020** dated **18th November, 2020** under Sections **498A/306/34** of the Indian Penal Code.

Having considered the materials on record and bearing in mind the general and omnibus nature of allegations and as the incident occurred 28 years after marriage and as the statutory presumption under Section 113A of the Evidence Act is not attracted in the facts of the case, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
