It is submitted by the learned Counsel appearing for the petitioners that there was dispute amongst family members.

Learned Counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Allegation of physical assault may be assessed in the light of the aforesaid submission and as the injuries does not appear to be grievous, we are inclined in granting anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
