

**C.R.M. 10301 of 2020**  
**(Through Video Conference)**

In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with Barjora P.S. Case No. 103 of 2019 dated 19.07.2019 under sections 448/341/324/325/307/427/379/506 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that there is political rivalry between the parties. Petitioners have been falsely implicated in the instant case due to political rivalry.

We have considered the materials on record and bearing in mind the nature of allegations in the light of the aforesaid submission relating to political rivalry and nature of injuries, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further

condition that the petitioner shall meet the investigating officer once in a week until further orders.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
