Leave is granted to the learned advocate-on-record for the petitioners to correct the cause title of the application in course of this day.

Chandan Mal, a co-accused is the principal assailant. He is presently in custody. Keeping in mind the extent of complicity of the petitioners in the alleged crime, we are inclined in granting anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the accused/petitioners, namely **(1) Satyam Mal @ Saptam Mal & (2) Sonali Mal**, be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
