In Re: An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with Gangarampur P.S. Case No. 210 of 2020 dated 29.06.2020 under Sections 406/420/379/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Having considered the materials on record and bearing in mind the nature of allegations essentially relates to breach of contractual obligations, we are inclined in granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
