Heard the learned Advocates appearing for the parties.

Petitioner is in no way related to the husband of the deceased housewife. He is the landlord of the premises where the couple resided.

Learned Advocate appearing for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

We find that the victim housewife committed suicide four years after marriage. Keeping in mind the extent of complicity of the petitioner in the alleged crime, we are inclined in granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/-, with two sureties of like amount each, to the

satisfaction of the arresting officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
