In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure filed on **07/01/2019** in connection with **Jalpaiguri Women** P.S. Case No. **144 of 2019** dated **07/11/2019** under Sections **498A/304B/34** of the Indian Penal Code and under Sections **4** of the D.P. Act.

Petitioner no.1 has been arrested. Accordingly, the application is dismissed as infructuous.

Having considered the materials in the case diary and bearing in mind the prima facie involvement of the petitioner no.2 in assaulting the victim housewife resulting in her unnatural death within six years of marriage and in view of the gravity of the offence and as the petitioner does not stand on the same footing with the co-accused person who has been granted pre-arrest bail, we are not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.
