

Learned advocate for the respondent/Police authorities submits that the petitioner cannot dictate what section should be added to the First Information Report. He further submits that at the appropriate stage the petitioner will be give an opportunity to pray for insertion of the sections,, which according to the petitioner have been purposely omitted by the Police authorities.

Having heard the learned advocates for the respective parties and having gone through the complaint filed before the Police authorities, in my opinion without deciding the merits of the claim of the petitioner this writ petition should be disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate representation before the Superintendent of Police, Alipurduar and the said Superintendent of Police upon consideration of the contents of the complaint, records and the investigation should take a reasoned decision on the said representation of the petitioner and redress the grievances of the petitioner.

It is further requested that the said Superintendent of Police should also ensure that free and fair investigation is done by the Police authorities.

With the above direction and observations this writ petition is disposed of without any order as to costs.
