Having considered the materials in the case diary and bearing in mind the extent of complicity of the petitioner in the alleged crime, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. Petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer and hand over his passport, if any, within four weeks from date. In the event he does not have a passport, he shall personally appear before the Investigating Officer and furnish an affidavit to that effect within the time frame mentioned hereinabove.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
