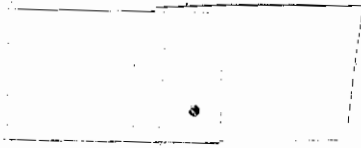

ORDER

In the instant Criminal appeal where the appellants have been convicted under Sections 341 and 322 read with section 34 IPC vide impugned judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 26.09.2002 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Mungeli (CG) in Sessions Trial No. 94/2001, the parties present in the National Lok Adalat held today including the complainant clearly state that they have compromised the
