Leaned counsel appearing for the Petitioner submits that the application for grant of leave/parole has been rejected by an unreasoned order passed on 21.05.2019, which runs contrary to the principle of law by this Court laid down in the matter of **Rakesh Shende v. State of Chhattisgarh** (in WPCR No. 29 of 2016, decided on 18.11.2016) and therefore, the said impugned order deserves to be set aside.
2. Learned State counsel submits that a fresh order for proposal for grant of leave on parole is underway and the same be passed within a period of 10 days from the date of presentation of certified copy of this order.
3. In view of submission made by learned counsel for the State/Respondents, the impugned order is hereby quashed and the

District Magistrate, Dhamtari is directed to consider and pass a fresh order with regard to grant of parole within a period of 10 days from the date of presentation of certified copy of this order.

4. The writ petition is allowed to the extent indicated hereinabove. A copy of this order be sent to the District Magistrate, Dhamtari for needful compliance by E-mail/Fax.
