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**Award****(Passed on 11<sup>th</sup> July, 2020)**

1. The contesting parties to this appeal have amicably settled/compromised the dispute, which is subject matter of this appeal, voluntarily. We have also found that the terms and conditions of compromise/settlement arrived at between the contesting parties are just, proper and legal. There is no legal impediment to compromise and hence are acceptable. We accordingly accept the compromise/settlement, proposed by the parties and order that the Respondent No.3/Insurance Company shall pay Rs. 1,85,000/- (one lack, eighty five thousand) by way of compensation in addition to the amount awarded by the Tribunal to the appellants within sixty days from today, failing which the respondent No. 3/Insurance Company shall be liable to pay interest @ 6% per annum from today till its payment.
