The petitioner at this juncture submits that he has also preferred an Election Petition under Section 122 of the Panchayat Raj Adhiniyam.

3. Given the fact that the petitioner has availed the statutory remedy available, this Court is of the opinion that no fruitful purpose would be served in issuing any writ to the respondents at this juncture.
4. With the aforesaid observations, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
