The applicants have preferred this application for grant of bail as they are arrested in connection with Crime No.78/2020 registered in Police Station Sakri, District Bilaspur for offence punishable under Section 34(2) & 59 (A) of the Chhattisgarh Excise Act for illegally possessing 8 liters & 5.30 bulk liters of country made liquor, respectively.
2. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to release the applicants on bail. Accordingly, the application is allowed and the applicants are directed to be released on bail on each of them executing

a personal bond for a sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety for the like amount to the satisfaction of the concerned **on duty remand Magistrate**. They are directed to appear before the trial Court on each and every date given by the said Court. It is made clear that if the applicants involve themselves in the offence of similar nature during the operation of this order, this order granting bail to the applicants shall automatically stand cancelled without reference to the Bench and the applicants shall be arrested forthwith.
