- 1.** The limited relief sought for by the petitioner in this petition is for an appropriate direction to the respondents to consider and decide his application for diversion of land bearing Khasra Nos.1284/4, 1285/2, 1286/3, Area 0.29, 0.77 and 0.14 Acres respectively for the purpose of construction of shopping complex.
- 2.** The writ petition was filed as early as in July, 2016. By efflux of time, much water must have flown.
