- (1) Proceedings of this matter have been taken up through video conferencing.
- (2) The accused/applicant has preferred this second bail application under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for releasing him on regular bail during trial in connection with Crime No. 170/2017 registered at Police Station – Hirri, District Bilaspur (C.G.) for the offence punishable under Section 20(B)(ii-c) of N.D.P.S. Act.
- (3) The applicant's first bail application was dismissed on merits by order of this Court dated 20.05.2019 passed in M.Cr.C. No. 3112 of 2019.
- (4) Having heard learned counsel for the parties, having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I do not find any change in circumstances to entertain this second bail application, therefore, this second bail application is rejected. However, since two prosecution witnesses are yet to be examined, therefore, the trial Court is

directed to examine these two witnesses expeditiously preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
