Considering the aforesaid submission learned counsel for the parties and that the parties are also present in the Court and have expressed in that manner, supported by their respective affidavits filed today itself and before us, we are inclined to allow the appellant to withdraw both the appeals.

6. Both the appeals are accordingly dismissed as withdrawn.
