1. Heard.
2. The limited grievance of the petitioners in the present writ petition is that they were appointed in service on 12.06.2014 and since then they are continuously working and their probation period of two years though is completed in the year 2016 but till date the respondent has not taken any decision so far as the confirmation of their services is concerned by speaking order.

3. Counsel for the petitioners makes a limited prayer that the respondents may be directed to consider the case of the petitioners at the earliest.
4. Considering the limited prayer made by the counsel for the petitioners, without commenting anything on the merits and entitlement of the petitioners at this juncture, let the petitioners make detailed representations to the respondents within a period of 15 days from today and on such representations being made, let the respondents consider the claim of the petitioners on its merits and pass a suitable order in accordance with the rules governing the field. Let this decision be taken within a further period of 90 days from the date of receipt of representations.
5. The writ petition accordingly stands disposed of.
